The project involves a 4-day conference on biotechnology, namely "Hong Kong Biotech Horizons" held on 20-23 September 2018 and a report on the conference to be uploaded onto website. The program included lectures by invited speakers, fellow presentations, interactive discussion sessions, etc. The project demonstrated Hong Kong as the super connector to facilitate connections among the bio-medical industry as well as an innovation hub with bio-medical focus in enhancing the standards and external competitiveness of Hong Kong's professional services.
